#### **Greek Comedy**

 $\rightarrow$  The greek comedy was a type of theatre that were made to entertain people.

 $\rightarrow$  Playwrights often made jokes about politics, ideas, and many - other events.

ex) Aristophanes "The Birds" "Lysistrata"






# The impact of greek drama throughout history and modern days (musicals)

### **The Delian League**

Members: The greek city states. -Aegina -Byzantium -Chios -Lesbos... Leader: Athens

#### Vocab

Delian League: Alliance of greek city-states led by Athens. (Formed in 478 BCE)

City-States: An independent sovereign city which is like a kind of a country with its own political, economic, and cultural life.

#### <u>Purpose</u>

To unite and fight against the invasion of Persia. (It was a league of greek city-states to protect themselves.)

#### **Treasury**

 $\rightarrow$  Kept in sacred island "Delos"

 $\rightarrow$  Athenians started to use the treasury of the league for Athens.



#### How Pericles (king of Athens) used the treasury!!

- $\rightarrow$  Strengthened the Athenian navy
- $\rightarrow$  Beautified Athens
- $\rightarrow$  Bought gold, ivory, marble for Athenians
- $\rightarrow$  Payed artists, architects, philosophers, and workers in Athens

#### **Philosophers**

 $\rightarrow$  Socrates

- →Encouraged people to examine beliefs
- $\rightarrow$  Believed that absolute

standards exist for truth and justice.

- $\rightarrow$  Plato (student of Socrates)
  - ightarrow "The Republic" (Perfectly governed

society)



#### $\rightarrow$ Aristotle




- $\rightarrow$  Questioned the nature of the world
- ightarrow Questioned human belief
- → Invented a method for arguing according to rules of logic

#### **Architecture**

- $\rightarrow$  Built 23,000 square-foot building in a traditional style
- $\rightarrow$  Built greek temples
- $\rightarrow$  Sculptors created sculptures of an ideal greek man.
  - $\rightarrow$  Strong
  - $\rightarrow$  Graceful
  - $\rightarrow$  Perfectly formed






## 3. Describe the elements of sculptures from The Golden Age of Greece, and explain why they looked this way.
